The LPN articulating to:	Associate Degree in Nursing*
Will be awarded <u>at least</u> the following number of semester credit hours	11 credit hours in nursing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NUR1021L • NUR1021C • NUR1141

*LPN-to-RN Associate Degree Programs, which admit only LPNs and no unlicensed students, may not record the articulating credit on the student's transcript until the time of program completion.

REQUIREMENT A: Successful completion of an LPN program

REQUIREMENT B: Passing the NCLEX-LPN licensure examination

REQUIREMENT C: Active Florida LPN license

Table 2: Nursing Credit Parameters for the Articulating RN who graduated from an associate degree program

The RN articulating to:	Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing*
Will be awarded <u>at least</u> the following number of semester credit hours.	14 credit hours in nursing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successfully completed the requirements UPP/NUR • Nursing Portfolio Completion • Student must meet BSN degree residency requirements for graduation and complete all other degree requirements

*RN-to-Baccalaureate Degree Programs, which admit only RNs and no LPNs or unlicensed students, may not record the articulating credit on the student's transcript until the time of program completion

REQUIREMENT A: Successful completion of an ADN program

REQUIREMENT B: Passing the NCLEX-RN licensure examination

REQUIREMENT C: Active Florida RN license

REQUIREMENT D: Must be accepted to the BSN program **unconditionally**

REQUIREMENT E: Student must successfully complete NUR3955 Portfolio I and NUR4956 Portfolio II at NWFSC

REQUIREMENT F: Student must be recommended by the NWFSC Director of Nursing
